Course of study focuses on developing knowledge and skills in supporting individual students with both vision and hearing impairments including those with significant and multiple disabilities.

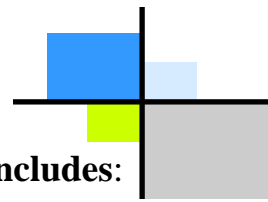
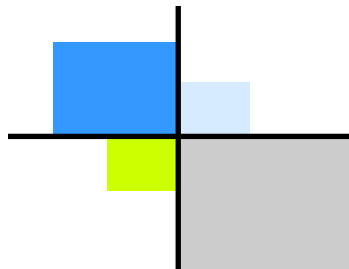
