

**Eligibility:** **Masters registration** is open to USATF-member athletes who are at least 30 years old on June 1, 2013.

**Paralympic registration** is open to athletes with a permanent physical or visual disability age 6 through adult. Disabilities may include, but are not limited to: amputation, cerebral palsy, dwarfism, muscular dystrophy, osteogenesis imperfecta, spina bifida, spinal cord injury, traumatic brain injury, or visual impairment. Athletes may be ambulatory or use a manual or power wheelchair.

**Registration:** Registration is available online at [5280challenge.com](http://5280challenge.com) through Tuesday, May 28, 2013. All registration will be submitted online via credit card.

**Entry Fee:** \$35.00 per registrant for unlimited events

\*\*Entry fee for Paralympic registrants includes Wheelchair and Ambulatory Sports USA (WASUSA) registration fee\*\*  
No charge for coaches or guides

**Sanctioning:** 5280 Challenge is sanctioned by USA Track and Field and WASUSA. This meet can qualify individual athletes for national competitions such as the National Jr. Disability Sports Championships, the National Veterans Wheelchair Games and the U.S. Paralympics Track & Field National Championships if qualifying standards in their respective events are met. In addition, those athletes with a current International Paralympic Committee (IPC) license can submit their performances to IPC for ranking.
