SERVICE AND POLICY PROPOSALS The development of the Transit Development Plan for Central Maryland began in the Fall of 2016. The purpose of the plan is to evaluate the performance of the existing transit service, identify public transit needs in the region, and develop proposals to meet those needs and improve transit service.

The service proposals that will be presented at the public meetings are the results of many community conversations and an enormous response to our surveys about how RTA can improve its service and transit network in the region.

The service proposals...

- Realign routes to meet current needs and changing land uses.
- Reduce ride times for riders.
- Increase frequencies on many routes.
- Improve connections to jobs and vital services.
- Add more service on the weekends.

Policy ideas will also be presented to address the growing demand for the paratransit service.

Public feedback from the meetings will be used to inform the full draft of the Transit Development Plan which is scheduled for completion by November 2017.


