**Eligibility:** Masters registration is open to USATF-member athletes who are at least 30 years old on June

1, 2013.

Paralympic registration is open to athletes with a permanent physical or visual disability age 6

through adult. Disabilities may include, but are not limited to: amputation, cerebral palsy,

dwarfism, muscular dystrophy, osteogenesis imperfecta, spina bifida, spinal cord injury, traumatic brain injury, or visual impairment. Athletes may be ambulatory or use a manual or power

wheelchair.

Registration: Registration is available online at 5280challenge.com through Tuesday, May 28, 2013. All

registration will be submitted online via credit card.

Deadline: Tuesday, May 28, 2013, 11:59 PM Mountain Time

Championships, the National Veterans Wheelchair Games and the U.S. Paralympics Track & Field National Championships if qualifying standards in their respective events are met. In addition, those athletes with a current International Paralympic Committee (IPC) license can

submit their performances to IPC for ranking.
