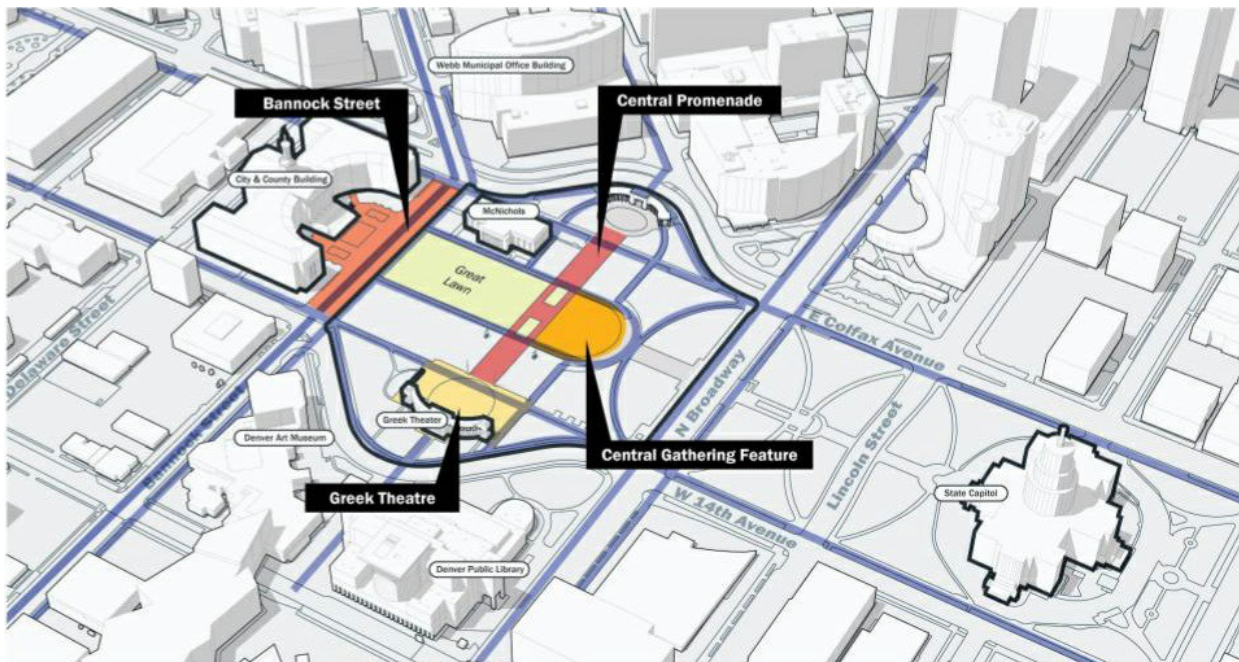
What do you imagine for the next 100 years of improvements to Civic Center?

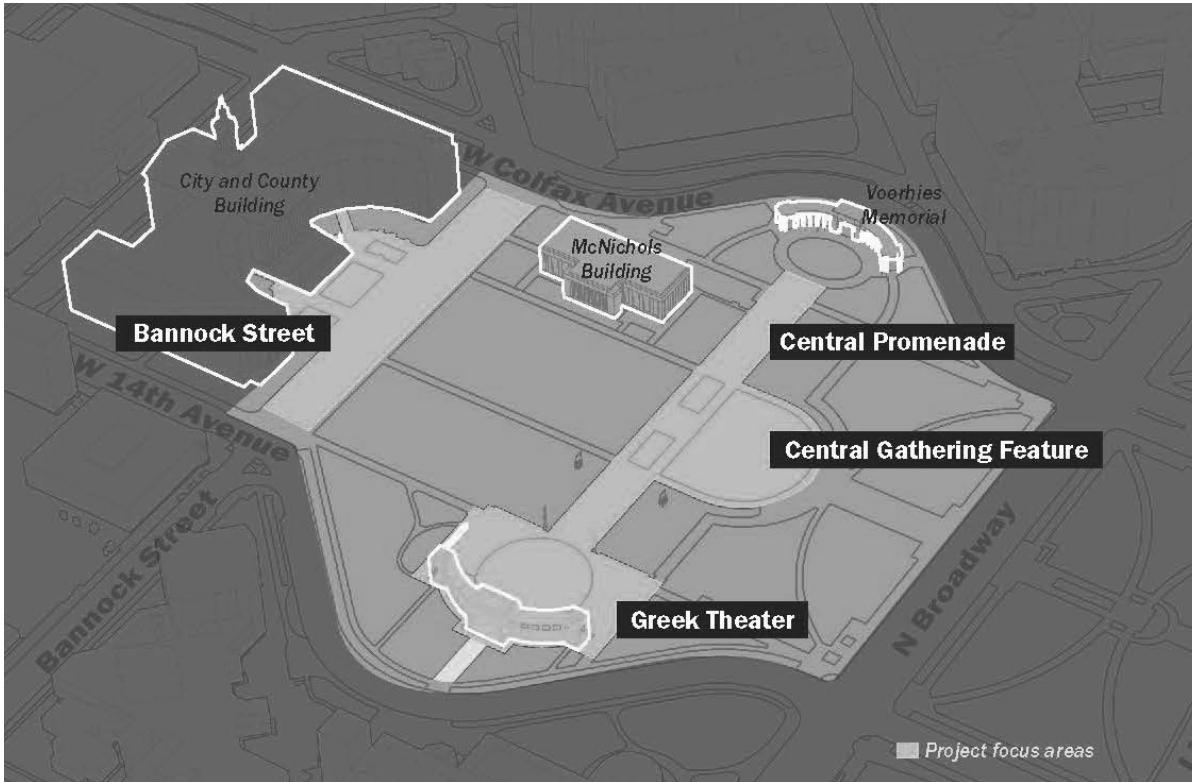

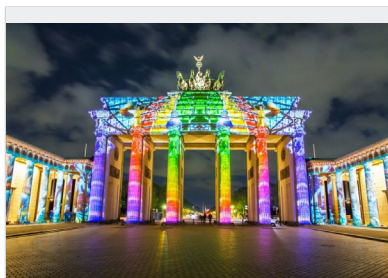
