Directions to Dove Pointe (Salisbury) From Baltimore:

Cross the Chesapeake Bay Bridge and take Route 50 East. Continue on Route 50 until you enter Salisbury. Drive through the light at Civic Avenue (there will be a Burger King on your right) and make a right at Beaglin Park Drive (the next intersection). Continue to bear right onto Mt. Hermon Road. Dove Pointe will be the 6th building on your right.

From Dover

Take Route 13 south to Salisbury and continue until you come to the Salisbury bypass. Merge right to enter the bypass (Zia's Pastaria and Arby's will be on your right). Continue on the bypass until you come to Route 50 West exit (the 1st exit you come to). After entering Route 50, continue through 2 intersections (Tilghman Road and Phillip Morris Drive). The next intersection is Beaglin Park Drive – bear left (there is no light here). Cross Route 50 East and bear right at the light (there is a yield sign as you merge) onto Mt. Hermon Road. Dove Pointe will be the 6th building on your right.

From I-83

Take Cold Spring Lane East - Exit 9A. Travel east approximately three miles to the corner of The Alameda and Cold Spring Lane. The League is on this corner. Proceed through the light and make your next right turn into our parking lot.

From 695

I-695 E/W towards Towson. Take Loch Raven Blvd. exit – 29B. Travel south on Loch Raven Boulevard approximately four miles and turn right onto East Cold Spring Lane. The League will be immediately on your left after passing the fire station and fire station traffic
