What is the New Bus Network?

The New Bus Network (you may remember it as Bus Revolution) is a redesign of SEPTA's bus system to better match how people travel today and rebalance service across the network by:

- **Simplifying** routes and connections
- **Running buses more often** where demand is highest
- **Improving reliability** across the region

When

Changes will begin in fall 2026 and roll out in phases through 2027.

What to Expect

The New Bus Network increases access to jobs, schools, and daily destinations across the region by providing:



New routes and route extensions to new destinations



More frequent service on key corridors including nights and weekends



Some low-ridership or duplicate services reduced or replaced



Easier connections between bus routes and to other transit services
