## **Rehabilitation Counseling RSA Scholars Program**

**Full tuition (9-12 credits per semester)\***

**One Stipend per Semester between \$1,000-\$2,500\***

The Rehabilitation Services Administration (RSA) has awarded the ESU Rehabilitation Counseling Program (RC48) with funds toward tuition and stipend support of up to 20 scholars. We are now accepting applications for our second cohort (10 students) to begin their studies Spring 2017.

### **Application Requirements**

- Must be a resident of Kansas or Nebraska
- Applicants must submit an online application and a \$40 application fee to the ESU Graduate School and complete all admission application requirements (including official transcripts and letters of recommendation) through [www.emporia.edu/grad/admissions/](http://www.emporia.edu/grad/admissions/)
- Applicants must submit online at [www.emporia.edu/teach/ce/rsa-scholars/](http://www.emporia.edu/teach/ce/rsa-scholars/) a (maximum) two-page letter of interest that includes:
  - Professional and/or personal experience with people who have disabilities
  - Statement of how the scholarship will contribute towards future professional goals working with people who have disabilities
  - Statement of how the student will utilize resources (i.e., academic, community, and family support, commitment to self-care, boundaries, work schedules, and study habits) to successfully complete an online degree
- Completion of the RSA Scholar Packet (materials online at [www.emporia.edu/teach/ce/rsa-scholars/](http://www.emporia.edu/teach/ce/rsa-scholars/))
- Completion of a video conference interview with ESU Rehabilitation Faculty (interviews may be scheduled prior to the deadline, but may not occur until after all applications have been submitted)
