What is it like at a delivery station?

- Delivery stations are the last stop for a package before a driver picks up and delivers.
- Smaller than fulfillment centers, delivery stations sort packages by zip code. Packages arrive already packed by the fulfillment centers.
- Once sorted, packages are stowed in bags and wait for the driver to pick them up for delivery!
- Delivery stations in our area include locations in: Bridgeview, IL, Romeoville, IL, Champaign, IL and Crown Pointe, IN.
