Get ready for Prime Day with epic savings in 24 countries

Prime Day, Amazon's two-day shopping extravaganza, is back, offering Prime members deals on top brands from fashion and electronics to toys and home.

The annual event will take place July 12-13 in 20 countries—Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brazil, Canada, China, France, Germany, Italy, Japan, Luxembourg, Mexico, the Netherlands, Portugal, Singapore, Spain, the UK, the U.S., and for the first time ever in Poland and Sweden. Later this summer, Prime Day deals events will be held in India, Saudi Arabia, and the United Arab Emirates, as well as in Egypt for the first time.

# Amazon launches employment support program for refugees

- A new Amazon program offers resources and support for refugee and humanitarian-based immigrant employees, including a citizenship assistance portal, free legal support, and mentorship.
- Amazon has launched the Welcome Door program, a new initiative to provide refugee and humanitarianbased immigrant employees with additional resources and support, along with reimbursement for **Employment Authorization** Document (EAD) fees. The program also offers employees access to upskilling opportunities, including free college tuition and English as a Second Language (ESL) proficiency through the Career Choice program.
