Did You Know/Work Perks Headline

Commutable distance can vary by city or region, but we expect onsite employees to live close enough to their assigned office location that they can easily travel to the office by mass transit, car, foot, bike, and so on, for a meeting within a day’s notice. As a guideline (but not a hard rule), that “daily commute” is typically within a 60-90 minute radius. If working on a visa, note that the definition may be stricter and require you to live within 50 mi. (80.5 km.) of your work location. Check with Global Immigration if this applies to you.
