Amazonians celebrate Black culture by joining the Bud Billiken Parade in Chicago

The annual Bud Billiken Parade—also known as “The Bud”—has been a celebration of African-American culture in the Chicago area since 1929, while connecting the community to resources that promote education and empowerment. This year, the WW Stores DEI team and BEN sponsored the event, allowing Amazonians to join in an official capacity for the first time. The parade just hit its 93rd year this month, and over 80 employees from Amazon’s Chicagoland network volunteered to pass out 450 backpacks packed with school supplies, along with 2,000 parade giveaways, and fruit from Amazon Fresh. What can you expect when applying to Amazon?



Here's what to expect from the moment you click "Apply" to your first day on the job.

1 JOB APPLICATION AND PREVIEW



Your online application consists of providing some information about yourself, completing an online assessment, and selecting your preferred shift. After you finish your application you will get an email with a link for a 30-minute Virtual Job Preview, where you'll learn more about your role at Amazon and the final steps before your first day. No travel required.

2 ATTEND OFFICE HOURS



After completing your Virtual Job Preview, you will attend an in-person 20-minute Office Hours appointment. When you go to this appointment, bring proof of your identity and employment eligibility.

3 COMPLETE ONLINE NEW HIRE ORIENTATION



After completing Office Hours steps, you will receive an email from KNET with instructions for your Online New Hire Orientation. During this online session, you'll learn about what it's like to work at Amazon, workplace safety, and proper attire to prepare you for your first day with Amazon.

4 YOUR FIRST DAY!



You will receive an email with schedule details. When you arrive to your first day at Amazon, you will dive deeper into the details of your work and learn important safety rules to keep you and your teammates safe.

If you do not find the shift that meets your expectations, you can still complete the application process and wait for the shift that works for you.
