

Tactile Trip Around the World!

Penn Museum invites visitors with vision loss to explore the museum through the senses!

Visitors with vision loss and their companions are invited to explore the Museum through the senses, including touch! The

program will feature sensory stations in eight galleries, including a chance to touch real artifacts. Museum staff will be stationed around the building to guide visitors who are blind or visually impaired through the tactile experiences, give verbal descriptions, and offer wayfinding assistance.

Visitors with vision loss who require or prefer sighted guides are encouraged to bring an assistant or companion.

The program is FREE with regular Museum admission (One sighted companion per visitor receives free admission). ACCESS cardholders receive a discounted admission of \$2 per person for up to 4 visitors.
