DISTANCE LEARNING:

Rehabilitation Teaching Master's Degree *including Orientation and Mobility* (54 credits) <u>Or</u> **Rehabilitation Teaching Master's Degree Program** (40 Credits)

- Fully online, except for 2-week summer labs held in Long Island and Manhattan
- No prior TVI certification needed
- Graduates eligible for national certification in VRT and/ or O&M to work with learners with visual impairments

Orientation and Mobility Advanced Certificate Program (20 credits)

- Must have Master's in VRT, TVI certified or ****NEW Now accepting Master's in OT & PT****
- Fully online, except for 2-week summer labs held in Long Island and Manhattan **Grant funding available for qualified applicants

Advanced Certificate in Teaching of Learners with Blindness and Visual Impairment (TVI)

- (22 credits) In-person for Metro NYC, Fully Online for Upstate NY Students
- Must have a Master's Degree with NYS Certification in any area of education **Grant funding available for qualified applicants
- *NEW* Combined Advanced Certificate in Teaching of Learners with Blindness and Visual Impairment & Orientation and Mobility (39 credits) – Hybrid model **Grant funding available for qualified applicants

ON-CAMPUS: (Hunter's campus will re-open Fall 2021, some classes may remain online)

Master's Degree in Blind and Visually Impaired

- Short program (40 credits) for those with New York State initial teacher certification
- Long Program (47-60 credits) for those who need teaching certification.
 **NYC DOE Scholarship Available

Master's Degree in Severe/ Multiple Disabilities

- Short program (37 credits) for those with New York State initial teacher certification
- Long Program (44-56 credits) for those who need teaching certification.
 **Qualifies for TEACH Grant funding

NEW Advanced Certificate In Severe/ Multiple Disabilities (19 credits)

- Extended coursework for those who already hold a special education certification
- Leads to NYS Annotation Extension, counts towards Masters + 30 and CTLE progress
