Dear Members of the Board,

I hope this message finds you well.

I am writing to inform you that I have completed my testing of the Square integration on the staging site of nfbar.org. All testing activities have been finalized, and I have submitted my feedback and detailed findings to Erin Rodney at the National Office for review and any necessary follow-up.

As part of my findings, I noted a minor adjustment needed to the spelling of “NFB of AR” on the Square checkout screen. Additionally, during testing it became clear that users must expand the order summary content toggle in order to enter the payer’s name, phone number, email address, and payment details (or select an available express payment option) before proceeding to complete the transaction. I have documented these items to help ensure a smooth and accessible user experience.

Once the National Office incorporates this minor update, they will sync the content from the staging site with the live site before pushing the Square integration updates. This approach will ensure that any post-convention revisions I have made to the website are preserved.

With the completion of this work, I am formally submitting my resignation as Web Coordinator for the National Federation of the Blind of Arkansas, effective immediately. Please consider this email as my official letter of resignation.

Serving in this role since 2020 has been both a meaningful and rewarding experience. Over the past six years, I have had the privilege of supporting the organization’s web presence and contributing to its digital accessibility efforts. I am sincerely grateful for the opportunity to serve and to work alongside dedicated leadership and members throughout that time. To support continuity, I remain available to assist with a smooth transition. I am happy to provide documentation, answer questions, or offer guidance regarding the website and related systems as needed.

Thank you again for the opportunity to serve, and I wish the Board continued success in your work on behalf of the Federation.
