Youth Programs and Greeley Schools Our Youth Open House connected us with new parents and youth in need of services and helped jump-start our iPad classes and recreational activities with youth.

We have been working with the Greeley School District to provide iPad classes for special needs students since early in the year, and we are now adding classes on life skills such as cooking. laundry, and money management.
