TO: BUS OPERATORS

RE: ALOHA FESTIVALS WAIKIKI HO'OLAULE'A/STREET FEST

In conjunction with the 2011 Aloha Festivals, the **ANNUAL WAIKIKI HO'OLAULE'A/STREET FEST** will be held from **7:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m., SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 17, 2011**. At 4:00 p.m., Kalakaua Avenue between Lewers Street and Kealohilani Avenue will be **CLOSED** to all vehicular traffic for set up of festival stages and booths along Kalakaua Avenue. Buses operating on **Route B, CityExpress!**, and **Route E, CountryExpress!** will detour as noted below:

4:00 P.M. TO MIDNIGHT**

DETOUR ROUTES

ROUTE B, CityExpress!

Eastbound: Regular route to bus stop at Kalakaua/Ena intersection. **DETOUR** by veering left to turn left onto Kuhio, right Ohua, left Kalakaua, left Kapahulu to terminus.
Westbound: No **DETOUR**.


Route E, CountryExpress!

Eastbound: Regular route to Saratoga/Kalakaua bus stop (opposite Waikiki Post Office). **DETOUR** by continuing mauka on Saratoga, onto Kalaimoku, right Kuhio, right Kapahulu, left Kalakaua, left Monsarrat to terminus.
Westbound: No **DETOUR**.

TEMPORARY BUS STOPS

Eastbound: All bus stops along your detour route.
Westbound: None.

All bus routes servicing the Waikiki area will experience delays due to heavy pedestrian and vehicular traffic. Please exercise patience and practice defensive driving at all times. Your cooperation is sincerely appreciated.
