**RE: APEC CITY BUS ROUTE DETOURS** 

The Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation Conference Leaders Week will be held on Oahu from **November 7 – 13, 2011**. Conferences and related events are being held in Waikiki at the Hawaii Convention Center and the Hale Koa Hotel, and in Ko Olina at the Ihilani Resort and Spa.

Major road closures and restricted zones will be established around these areas for security reasons. *City buses will be affected by these road closures and restricted areas only in the Ala Moana and Waikiki areas*. There will be no City bus detours for events at the Ihilani Resort area. These detours *DO NOT* include the temporary closures of surface streets, freeways and highways when HPD needs to move the APEC VIPs and attendees to and from various locations.

City bus detours will be affected in two phases, with the first phase starting at Tuesday, November 8<sup>th</sup>, through Friday, November 11<sup>th</sup>, between the hours of 6:00 a.m. through 7:00 p.m. daily. The second phase is starting from 7:00 p.m. Friday, November 11<sup>th</sup>, through 11:59 p.m., Sunday, November 13<sup>th</sup>, 24 hours a day.

BECAUSE ROAD CLOSURES ARE CONTROLLED BY THE FBI AND STATE DEPARTMENTS, THESE DETOURS ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE WITHOUT ADVANCE NOTICE.

# APEC DETOUR ROUTES: SERVICE ALL BUS STOPS ALONG YOUR DETOUR ROUTES

PHASE 1: TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2011, THROUGH FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 11, 2011, 6:00 A.M TO 7:00 P.M. DAILY (Subject to change via HPD or OTS notification)

Kapiolani Boulevard in both directions will be closed between Kaheka Street (Koko-Head intersection) and Kalakaua Avenue (Ewa intersection).

#### Route A, CityExpress!

Eastbound: Regular route to the Kapiolani/Keeaumoku bus stop. <u>DETOUR</u> by veering to the left lane to turn left onto Kaheka, right King, (service only the King/Punahou and King/McCully bus stops). Then turn left University, resuming regular route east to

Sinclair Circle.

Westbound: Regular route to the Kapiolani/McCully bus stop. Continue west on Kapiolani in the right lane, **DETOUR** right Kalakaua, left Makaloa, left Sheridan, right Kapiolani,

resuming regular route, servicing all stops along detour route.

## Route 3, Kaimuki-Salt Lake Route 9, Palolo Valley-Pearl Harbor

Eastbound: Regular route to the Kapiolani/Keeaumoku bus stop. **DETOUR** by veering to the

left lane to turn left onto Kaheka, right Kanunu, right Kalakaua (use the center lane and turn left with HPD approval and/or instructions), resuming regular route east.

Westbound: Regular route to the Kapiolani/McCully bus stop. Continue west on Kapiolani in

the right lane, **DETOUR** right Kalakaua, left Makaloa, left Sheridan, right Kapiolani,

resuming regular route.

Route B, CityExpress!

Eastbound: Regular route to the Kalakaua/Ena bus stop. DETOUR by continuing east on

Kalakaua, **DETOUR** left Kuhio, right Kapahulu, left Kalakaua to the temporary

terminus on Monsarrat fronting the Waikiki Shell.

Westbound: From the temporary terminus, mauka on Monsarrat, left Paki, left Kapahulu, right

Kuhio, resuming regular route west.

Route E, CountryExpress!

Regular route to the Ala Moana Blvd/Kamakee bus stop. DETOUR by continuing Eastbound:

> east on the left lane to turn left Piikoi, right Kona to unload passengers at the Kona/Kona lki Stop #9 and Windward Stop #2 (Kona ewa of Keeaumoku). **DETOUR** "NOT IN SERVICE" to the temporary terminus via east on Kona, left Mahukona (around the pillars), left ewa on Kona to the temporary terminus on

Kona between Keeaumoku and Piikoi.

Westbound: From temporary terminus, "NOT IN SERVICE" via west on Kona, right Piikoi, right

Kapiolani, right Kona Iki, left Kona, right Mahukona, right Atkinson, right Ala Moana Blvd to the starting point at Ala Moana Blvd/AMC Makai bus stop;

resuming regular route west.

Route 8, Waikiki-Ala Moana

Regular route to Mahukona/Atkinson. **DETOUR** left Atkinson, right Kapiolani, right Eastbound:

Kalakaua, left Kuhio, resuming regular route afer crossing Kalaimoku.

WHEN PROCEEDING EASTBOUND FROM ALA MOANA CENTER. BE SURE TO PICK UP INTENDING PASSENGERS FOR ROUTES 23 AND 24, ALLOWING THEM TO TRANSFER TO THESE ROUTES ALONG KUHIO

AVENUE OR AT KAPIOLANI PARK.

Westbound: Regular route to the Kuhio/Launiu bus stop. DETOUR by continuing west on

Kuhio, onto Kalakaua (bus lane), left Kapiolani, left Atkinson, right Ala Moana Blvd,

right Piikoi, right Kona to the Kona/Keeaumoku Stop #3.

WHEN PROCEEDING WESTBOUND FROM THE MONSARRAT TERMINUS AND ALONG KUHIO AVENUE, BE SURE TO PICK UP INTENDING PASSENGERS FOR ROUTES E, 19, 20, AND 42, ALLOWING THEM TO

TRANSFER TO THESE ROUTES AT ALA MOANA CENTER MAKAI.

Route 19, Waikiki-Airport-Hickam Route 20, Waikiki-Pearlridge

Eastbound: Regular route to the Kona/Keeaumoku Stop #3. DETOUR "NOT IN SERVICE" via

east on Kona, left Mahukona (around the pillars), left Kona, to the temporary

terminus on Kona between Keeaumoku and Piikoi.

Westbound: From the temporary terminus, "NOT IN SERVICE" via west on Kona, right Piikoi,

right Kapiolani, right Kona Iki, left Kona, right Mahukona, right Ala Moana Blvd to the starting point at Ala Moana Blvd/AMC Makai bus stop; resuming regular route

west.

Route 23, Hawaii Kai-Sea Life Park Route 24, Aina Haina-Ala Moana

From the temporary Pau/Ala Wai terminus, mauka on Pau, left Ala Wai, left Niu,

left Kalakaua, left Kuhio, resuming regular route east after crossing Kalaimoku.

Regular route to the Kuhio/Launiu bus stop. **DETOUR** by continuing west on Westbound:

Kuhio, onto Kalakaua (bus lane), right Pau to the temporary terminus at

Pau/Ala Wai.

Route 42, Ewa Beach-Waikiki

Eastbound: Regular route to the Ala Moana/Queen bus stop. DETOUR east on Ala Moana

Blvd, left Piikoi, right Kona to the Kona/Kona Iki Stop #9 and Windward Kona/ewa of Keeaumoku Stop #2 bus stops. <u>DETOUR</u> "NOT IN SERVICE" via east on Kona, left Mahukona (around the pillars), left Kona, to the temporary terminus on

Kona between Keeaumoku and Piikoi.

Westbound: From the temporary terminus, "NOT IN SERVICE" via west on Kona, right Piikoi,

right Kapiolani, right Kona Iki, left Kona, right Mahukona, right Atkinson, right Ala Moana Blvd To the starting point at Ala Moana Blvd/AMC Makai bus stop;

resuming regular route.

Route 201, Waipahu via Farrington Express

A.M. Operation: Regular route on the H-1 Freeway EAST Airport Viaduct. DETOUR by

continuing on H-1 Freeway to take EXIT 25A "King St", onto King, onto Harding, right Kapahulu, right Kuhio, onto Kalakaua (bus lane) to the finish

point at Kalakau/Pau.

P.M. Operation: From the temporary starting point at the Kuhio/Namahana bus stop, east on

Kuhio, resuming regular route after crossing Kalaimoku.

Route 202, Waipahu via Paiwa Express

A.M. Operation: Regular route to H-1 Freeway EAST on the Zipper Lane and Keehi

Interchange. <u>DETOUR</u> by exiting the Zipper Lane at the Keehi Interchange crossover, continue east on H-1 Freeway to take EXIT 25A "King St", onto King, onto Harding, right Kapahulu, right Kuhio, onto Kalakaua (bus lane) to

the finish point at Kalakau/Pau.

<u>P.M. Operation</u>: From the temporary starting point at the Kuhio/Namahana bus stop, east on

Kuhio, resuming regular route after crossing Kalaimoku Street.

Route 203, Kalihi via School Express

A.M. Operation: Regular route to the H-1 Freeway EAST. DETOUR to EXIT 25 "King St",

onto King, onto Harding, right Kapahulu, right Kuhio, onto Kalakaua (bus

lane) to the finish point at Kalakaua/Pau.

<u>P.M. Operation</u>: From the temporary starting point at the Kuhio/Namahana bus stop, east on

Kuhio, resuming regular route after crossing Kalaimoku Street.
