**TO: BUS OPERATORS**

**RE: WAIKIKI HOLIDAY PARADE**

The Waikiki Holiday Parade, sponsored by Gateway Music Festival Tours/Superior Bands, will be held at **7:00 P.M., FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 25, 2011**, along the following route:

**From the Kalakaua/Saratoga starting point, east on Kalakaua, left Monsarrat, terminating at the Queen Kapiolani Park.**

The parade route and all cross streets will be CLOSED PROGRESSIVELY. City buses on the following routes will detour as outlined at approximately **6:30 p.m. or when directed by the police, OTS Central Control or Road Supervisors.** Note: Saratoga Road between Kalakaua Avenue and Kalia Road may be closed from 6:15 p.m.

**NOTE: SERVICE ALL BUS STOPS ALONG YOUR DETOUR ROUTE.**

**6:30 P.M. TO APPROXIMATELY 8:00 P.M.**

**NOTES:**

1. SERVICE ALL BUS STOPS ALONG YOUR DETOUR ROUTE.
2. During the parade, operators on Routes E, 8, 19, 20, 23, 24, and 42 please pick up ALL PASSENGERS AT ALL BUS STOPS ALONG KALIA ROAD and direct them to transfer to their desired routes either on Ala Moana Boulevard or on Kuhio Avenue.

**Route B, CityExpress!**

Eastbound: Regular route to Kalakaua/Ena bus stop. **DETOUR** by merging into left lane to turn left Kuhio, left Kapahulu, right Leahi to temporary terminus at Leahi/Lakimau (Paki Park).

Westbound: From temporary terminus, continue **DETOUR** via kokohead on Leahi, right Monsarrat, right Paki, left Kapahulu, right Kuhio, resuming regular route.

**Route E, CountryExpress!**

Eastbound: Regular route to Kalia/Army Museum driveway. **DETOUR** right counter-clockwise around Army Museum turnaround, exit left Kalia, right Ala Moana, right Kalakaua, left Kuhio to Kuhio/Kapahulu, left Kapahulu, right Leahi to temporary terminus at Leahi/Lakimau (Paki Park).

Westbound: From temporary terminus, continue **DETOUR** via kokohead on Leahi, right Monsarrat, right Paki, left Kapahulu, right Kuhio, regular route to Kuhio/Lewers bus stop. **DETOUR** by continuing ewa on Kuhio, servicing the temporary bus stop at Kuhio/Olohana, right Kalakaua, right Pau, left Ala Wai, left Niu, onto Ala Moana, servicing the temporary stop at Today's Restaurant, resuming regular route.

**Route 2, Waikiki-School-Middle**

Eastbound: Regular route to temporary bus stop at Kuhio/Kapahulu. **DETOUR** left Kapahulu, right Leahi, right Noela, left Paki, right Kalakaua (ewa-bound), left at the Dillingham Fountain, left Kalakaua (kokohead-bound), resuming regular route to Paki/Poni Moi terminus.

Westbound: No detour.

**Route 4, Nuuanu-Punahou**

Eastbound: Regular route to temporary bus stop at Kuhio/Kapahulu. **DETOUR** left Kapahulu, right Leahi to temporary terminus at Leahi/Lakimau (Paki Park).

Westbound: From temporary terminus, continue **DETOUR** via kokohead on Leahi, right Monsarrat, right Paki, resuming regular route.

**Route 8, Waikiki-Ala Moana**  
**Route 19, Waikiki-Airport-Hickam**

**Route 20, Waikiki-Pearlridge**  
**Route 42, Ewa Beach-Waikiki**

**Eastbound:** Regular route to bus stop at Kalia Road/Hale Koa Hotel. Continue kokohead on Kalia to the U.S. Army Museum driveway. **DETOUR** right counter-clockwise around the driveway, left Kalia (see Note #2 on Page 1), right Ala Moana, right Kalakaua, left Kuhio, resuming regular route to temporary bus stop at Kuhio/Kapahulu. **DETOUR** left Kapahulu, right Leahi, to temporary terminus at Leahi/Lakimau (Paki Park).

**Westbound:** From temporary terminus, continue **DETOUR** via kokohead on Leahi, right Monsarrat, right Paki, resuming regular route until Kuhio/Launiu. From this point, **DETOUR** by continuing ewa on Kuhio, right Kalakaua, right Pau, left Ala Wai, left Niu, onto Ala Moana, resuming regular route.

**Route 14, St. Louis-Kahala-Maunalani**

**Eastbound:** Regular route to Kapahulu/Lemon. **DETOUR** right Lemon, right Paoakalani, right Kuhio, left Kapahulu, right Leahi, right Noela, left Paki, right Kalakaua (ewa-bound) left at the Dillingham Fountain, left Kalakaua (kokohead-bound), resuming regular route.

**Westbound:** No detour.

**Route 23, Hawaii Kai-Sea Life Park**

**Eastbound:** **To Hawaii Kai/Sea Life Park** – Regular route to bus stop at Kalia Road/Hale Koa Hotel. Continue kokohead on Kalia to the U.S. Army Museum driveway. **DETOUR** right counter-clockwise around the driveway (see Note #2 on Page 1), left Kalia, right Ala Moana, right Kalakaua, left Kuhio, resuming regular route to temporary bus stop at Kuhio/Kapahulu. **DETOUR** left Kapahulu, right Leahi, left Monsarrat, resuming regular route.

**Westbound:** Regular route to Kuhio/Launiu. **DETOUR** by continuing ewa along Kuhio, right Kalakaua, right Pau, left Ala Wai, left Niu, onto Ala Moana, resuming regular route.

**Route 24, Aina Haina-Ala Moana**

**Eastbound:** Regular route to bus stop at Kalia/Hale Koa Hotel. Continue kokohead on Kalia to the U.S. Army Museum driveway. **DETOUR** right counter-clockwise around the driveway (see Note #2 on Page 1), left Kalia, right Ala Moana, right Kalakaua, left Kuhio, regular route to temporary bus stop at Kuhio/Kalakaua. **DETOUR** left Kapahulu, right Leahi, left Monsarrat, resuming regular route.

**Westbound:** Regular route to Kuhio/Launiu. **DETOUR** by continuing ewa on Kuhio, right Kalakaua, right Pau, left Ala Wai, left Niu, onto Ala Moana, resuming regular route from Ena Road.


**EASTBOUND:**

1. On U.S. Army Museum driveway (Routes E, 8, 19, 20, 23, 24, 42)
2. On Kalia Road east of Ala Moana Boulevard (Routes E, 8, 19, 20, 23, 24, 42)
3. On Kuhio Avenue, ewa side of Kapahulu Avenue (Routes B, E, 2, 4, 8, 13, 14, 19, 20, 22, 23, 24, 42)
4. On Leahi, ewa of Lakimau Street (Paki Park) (Routes B, E, 2, 4, 8, 14, 19, 20, 22, 23, 24, 42)
5. At Dillingham Fountain turnaround (Routes 2, 14)

**WESTBOUND:**

1. On Kapahulu Avenue, at Kuhio Avenue (Routes B, E, 2, 4, 8, 13, 14, 19, 20, 22, 23, 24, 42)
2. On Kuhio Avenue, kokohead of Olohana Street (Routes E, 2, 4, 8, 13, 19, 20, 22, 23, 24, 42)
3. On Ala Moana Boulevard, mauka of Kalia/Ena Roads (Today's) (Routes E, 8, 19, 20, 23, 24, 42)

**RE: 65<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL KEIKI KALIKIMAKA HAWAII KAI CHRISTMAS PARADE**

The annual Keiki Kalikimaka Hawaii Kai Christmas Parade will be held at **on SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 26, 2011, commencing at 10:00 A.M.**, along the following route:

From Lunalilo Home Road/Hawaii Kai Drive (Kamiloiki Community Park), proceeding makai in all the westbound lanes of Lunalilo Home Road, to the mauka driveway of the Koko Marina Shopping Center (opposite Hawaii Kai Library).

**CAUTION: A CONTRA-FLOW LANE FOR WESTBOUND (makai-bound) TRAFFIC WILL BE ESTABLISHED ON LUNALILO HOME ROAD ALONG THE PARADE ROUTE UTILIZING ONE MAUKA-BOUND LANE.**

Operators on the following routes will **DETOUR** as outlined below at approximately **9:30 A.M.**, or when directed by the police, OTS Road Supervisor or Central Control.

**NOTE: SERVICE ALL BUS STOPS ALONG YOUR DETOUR ROUTE.  
(USE CAUTION WHEN SERVICING BUS STOPS IN THE CONTRA-FLOW LANE. WAIT FOR RIDERS TO WALK ACROSS THE CONED AREA).**

**DETOURS**  
**SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 26, 2011**

**Route 1, Kaimuki-Kalihi**

Eastbound: No detour.

Westbound: Regular route to the Lunalilo Home Road/Hawaii Kai Drive (Kamiloiki Community Park) intersection. **DETOUR** into the makai-bound "CONTRA-FLOW" lane, resuming regular route after crossing the Lunalilo Home Road/Kaumakani (makai-end) intersection.

**Route 23, Hawaii Kai-Sea Life Park**

Eastbound: Regular route to service the appropriate Hawaii Kai Park and Ride bus stop. EXIT the Park and Ride Facility to **DETOUR** right Keahole, left Kalaniana'ole Highway, left Lunalilo Home Road, resuming regular route after passing the Lunalilo Home Road/Wailua Street intersection.

Westbound: Regular route to the Hawaii Kai Drive/Lunalilo Home Road intersection. **DETOUR** left into the "CONTRA-FLOW" westbound coned lane, continuing on Lunalilo Home Road past the Wailua Street intersection, right Kalaniana'ole Highway, right Keahole, left into the Hawaii Kai Park and Ride Facility to service the appropriate bus stop. Exit the Park and Ride, right Keahole, right Kalaniana'ole Highway, resuming regular route.


**Route 231, Hahaione Valley-Koko Marina**

Eastbound to Koko Marina and the Park and Ride Facility: From the Hawaii Kai Park and Ride bus stop, exit the Park and Ride Facility and **DETOUR** right Keahole, left Kalaniana'ole Highway, left Lunalilo Home Road, right at the mauka end of Kaumakani, resuming regular route via Kaumakani, right Lunalilo Home Road, right Anapalau, right Hanamaulu, left Kaumakani, to the Kaumakani/Lunalilo Home Road intersection. **DETOUR** left into the makai-bound contra-flow lane of Lunalilo Home Road, right Kalaniana'ole Highway, right Keahole, left into the Hawaii Kai Park and Ride Facility to the Route 231 bus stop.

Westbound to Hahaione Valley and the Park and Ride Facility: From the Hawaii Kai Park and Ride bus stop, exit to left Keahole, left Hawaii Kai Drive, right Pepeekeo, left Ainapo to Hahaione, right Hahaione, left Hawaii Kai Drive, right Keahole, right into the Hawaii Kai Park and Ride Facility to the appropriate bus stop.

**TO: BUS OPERATORS**

**RE: WAIANAE COAST CHRISTMAS PARADE**

The annual Waianae Coast Christmas Parade will commence at **10:00 a.m., Saturday, November 26, 2011**, along the following route:

From the Waianae Small Boat Harbor Road, right Farrington Highway (all eastbound lanes) to Old Government Road intersection (7-Eleven Store). From this point, the parade will utilize all lanes of Farrington Highway between Old Government Road and Leihoku Street, terminating in the Waianae Mall parking lot.

**NOTE:** Contra-flow eastbound and westbound lanes on Farrington Highway between Waianae Harbor and Old Government Road (7-Eleven Store) will be set up to detour City buses only, between Waianae McDonald's and Waianae 7-Eleven Store.

Operators on the following routes should detour as noted below at approximately 9:45 A.M., or when directed by the Police, OTS Central Control, or Road Supervisors.

**NOTE: SERVICE ALL BUS STOPS ALONG YOUR DETOUR ROUTE**

**Route C, CountryExpress!**

**Route 40/40A, Honolulu-Makaha**

**Eastbound:** Regular route east along Farrington to Waianae Small Boat Harbor Road. **DETOUR** by utilizing the contra-flow lane on Farrington Highway to Old Government Road (7-Eleven Store). **DETOUR** left Old Government Road, right Plantation, right Mill, left Lualualei Homestead Road, right Moekahi, right Leihoku, right to Waianae Transit Center. Exit right Leihoku, left Farrington, resuming regular route.

**Westbound:** Regular route west to Waianae Transit Center. Exit to **DETOUR** left Leihoku, left Moekahi, left Lualualei Homestead Road, right Mill, left Plantation, left Old Government Road (7-Eleven Store), right Farrington, resuming regular route after passing the Waianae Small Boat Harbor Road.

**Route 401, Waianae Valley**

**Route 402, Lualualei Homestead Road**

Because of the parade utilizing Farrington Highway in Waianae Town, trips to Waianae Valley and Lualualei Homestead Valley will be combined into a single trip. **From Waianae Transit Center to Waianae Valley and then to Lualualei Homestead Valley:** Exit the Waianae Transit Center, **DETOUR** left onto Leihoku, left Moekahi, left Lualualei Homestead Road, right Mill, right Waianae Valley Road, turn around at Haleahi, makai on Waianae Valley Road, left Kaneaki, right Kepauala, left Kaneilio, right Kapaekahi, left Kaneaki, left Punanaula, right Kumaipo, right Kepauala, left Kaneaki, left Waianae Valley Road, right Plantation Drive, left Mill, left Lualualei Homestead Road, veer left onto Halona, left Puhawai, right Puuhulu, right Kuwale, right Lualualei Homestead Road, right Puhawai, left Halona, right Lualualei Homestead Road, left Moekahi, right Leihoku, right Waianae Transit Center to the Route 403 bus stop.

**Route 403, Nanakuli-Maili-Waianae Transit Center**

**Waianae Transit Center to Maili and Nanakuli:** From the Waianae Transit Center, right Leihoku, left Farrington, resuming regular eastbound route to Maili and Nanakuli.

**Nanakuli and Maili to Waianae Transit Center:** No detour to the Waianae Transit Center.

As with all other detours, operators are cautioned to expect delays, remain alert at all times, and to anticipate the unexpected especially while traveling through this area. If you are questioned, please exercise **PATIENCE** and **POLITELY** explain that this is an annual event over which we have no control.
