RE: 65<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL KAIMUKI TOWN CHRISTMAS PARADE

The 65<sup>th</sup> Annual <u>Kaimuki Town Christmas Parade</u> will be held on <u>THURSDAY</u>, <u>DECEMBER 1</u>, <u>2011</u>, <u>at 6:00 p.m.</u>, along the following route:

From entrance to St. Louis/Chaminade campus (3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue/Waialae Avenue), left on Waialae Avenue (all eastbound lanes), right Koko Head Avenue, right into Kaimuki Municipal Parking Lot.

At approximately 5:15 p.m., traffic patterns in the area will change, necessitating the following precautions and detours:

- 1. An EASTBOUND CONTRA-FLOW lane will be established in the left lane of the westbound traffic lanes of Waialae Avenue between 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and Koko Head Avenue.
  - Eastbound buses are to remain in the regular curb lane until directed by HPD or the OTS Road Supervisor to move into the contra-flow lane.
  - While the parade is in progress, please have all passengers disembark through the front door.
  - Eastbound traffic in the contra-flow lane will be allowed to make left turns from Waialae Avenue only at the following intersections: Waialae Avenue/Palolo Avenue; Waialae Avenue/10<sup>th</sup> Avenue; Waialae Avenue/Koko Head Avenue.
- 2. Due to anticipated traffic congestion during the parade (approximately 5:15 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.), Routes 3 and 14 operators are asked to minimize layover time at Koko Head Avenue Terminus.

#### **DETOURS**

Route 1, Kaimuki-Kalihi

Eastbound: Regular route to Waialae Avenue/3rd Avenue. When directed by HPD or the Road

Supervisor, veer into the eastbound contra-flow lane on Waialae Avenue, returning

to the regular eastbound lanes after crossing Koko Head Avenue.

Westbound: Regular route to Waialae Avenue/Koko Head Avenue. DETOUR right Koko Head

Avenue, left Sierra Drive, right Waialae Avenue, resuming regular routes.

# Routes 1 and 3 "Not In Service" Routes From Koko Head Avenue Terminus

From Koko Head Avenue, **DETOUR** right Waialae Avenue, left 21<sup>st</sup> Avenue, (under H-1 Freeway), left Waialae Avenue, to access H-1 Freeway WEST, resuming regular route to car house.

## Route 3, Kaimuki-Salt Lake

Eastbound: No detour. Please minimize the layover time.

Westbound: From terminus, DETOUR right Waialae Avenue, right 13th Avenue, right Mahina

Avenue, left Kokohead Avenue, resuming regular route.

Route 9, Palolo Valley-Pearl Harbor

Eastbound: No detour. NOTE: Regular route to Waialae Avenue/3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue. When directed

by HPD or the Road Supervisor, veer into the eastbound contra-flow lane on

Waialae Avenue, left Palolo Avenue, resuming regular route.

Westbound: No detour. (Use caution when making the right turn from 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue onto Waialae

Avenue).

#### Route 14, St. Louis-Kahala-Maunalani

<u>Eastbound</u>: No detour. **NOTE**: Minimize any service time at the Koko Head Avenue bus stop. Westbound: From Sierra Drive/Waialae Avenue, use caution when turning left into the eastbound contra-flow lane of Waialae Avenue. **DETOUR** by continuing east on Waialae Avenue, right 13th Avenue, right Harding Avenue, left Koko Head Avenue, resuming regular route.

Operators are cautioned to expect delays. As always, remain alert at all times and anticipate the unexpected, especially while traveling through the detour area. If you are questioned, please exercise PATIENCE and POLITELY EXPLAIN that this is an annual event over which we have no control. If you encounter any problems, contact Central Control or the Road Supervisor in the area.

Eastbound: Regular route to Liliha/King/Dillingham intersection. DETOUR left King, left

Beretania, right River, left Hotel, left Alakea, onto Queen Emma, right Vineyard, right Lusitana, right Alapai to Beretania. Cross Beretania to enter the Alapai Street contra-flow lane (makai-bound), left King, right Ward, left Kapiolani, resuming

regular route.

Westbound: No detour.

#### NOTE: SERVICE ALL BUS STOPS ALONG YOUR DETOUR ROUTE

Route 55, Kaneohe-Circle Island Route 56, Honolulu-Kailua-Kaneohe Route 57, Kailua-Waimanalo-Sea Life Park Route 57A, Kailua-Keolu Drive Route 65, Honolulu-Kahaluu (all trips)

Eastbound: (Windward to AMC): Regular route to Pali/Beretania bus stop. With HPD assistance, **DETOUR** by proceeding makai onto Bishop, left Hotel, left Alakea onto Queen Emma, right Vineyard, right Lusitana, right Alapai to Beretania. Cross Beretania to enter the Alapai Street contra-flow lane (makai-bound), left King, right Ward, left Ala Moana, resuming regular route.

NOTE: Route 65: from Ward/Ala Moana onto Ilalo to terminus at Ilalo/Coral.

Westbound: (AMC to Windward): Regular route to Alakea/Ala Moana Boulevard bus stop. DETOUR Alakea, right Queen, left South, onto Alapai, left Beretania, left Richards, right Hotel, right Alakea, resuming regular route.

NOTE: Route 65: Regular route to Forrest/Ala Moana Boulevard. DETOUR onto South, Alapai, left Beretania, left Richards, right Hotel, right Alakea, resuming regular route.

#### **AFTER PARADE DETOURS**

After the Parade ends on King in front of Honolulu Hale (kokohead of King/Punchbowl intersection), HPD will re-direct ALL EASTBOUND King Street traffic to turn makai on Punchbowl, in two (2) turning lanes. The eastbound King/Punchbowl bus stop will be TEMPORARILY CLOSED AND RELOCATED MAKAI ON PUNCHBOWL to alleviate traffic and pedestrian congestion. Service this temporary bus stop until the regular King/Punchbowl bus stop is re-opened.

#### **DETOUR ROUTE**

Regular route to the King/Mililani intersection (King Kamehameha Statue). Continue in the right lane of King, **<u>DETOUR</u>** right Punchbowl to the temporary bus stop, then:

Routes A, C, 3, 9, 40, 52, 53, and 62: <u>DETOUR</u> left Queen, left South, right Kapiolani, resuming regular route.

Routes B, 1, 2, and 13: <u>DETOUR</u> left Queen, left South, right King, resuming regular

Route 4 (Eastbound): <u>DETOUR</u> left Queen, left South, onto Alapai, resuming regular route.

Routes 11 and 54: <u>DETOUR</u> left Queen, left South, right King, left Alapai Express Lot to terminus.

Routes 19, 20, and 42: <u>DETOUR</u> makai on Punchbowl, resuming regular route.

#### REMINDER

ALL EASTBOUND ROUTES: A, B, C, 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 11, 13, 19, 20, 40, 42, 52, 53, 54, AND 62, SERVICING THE KING/PUNCHBOWL BUS STOP SHALL SERVICE THE TEMPORARY BUS STOP ON PUNCHBOWL STREET MAKAI OF KING STREET UNTIL THE REGULAR KING/PUNCHBOWL STREET BUS STOP IS RE-OPENED.

Road Supervisors will be stationed at key intersections to assist you with these detours. As on other occasions, many patrons will be inconvenienced. Please exercise PATIENCE and POLITELY EXPLAIN that this is an annual event over which we have no control.
