TO: BUS OPERATORS

RE: 2012 HAPALUA HALF MARATHON RUN

On <u>Sunday, March 11, 2012</u>, the inaugural "Hapalua Half Marathon Run," sponsored by the Honolulu Marathon, will be held. Approximately 3,000 runners are expected to participate in this event, which will start at 6:00 a.m.

The race course is as follows:

At the starting point, runners will use all lanes of Kalakaua Avenue fronting the Duke Kahanamoku statue. Proceeding west, runners will use the three makai lanes of Kalakaua Avenue (mauka lane will be open for regular traffic), proceed left onto all the eastbound lanes of Ala Moana Boulevard, proceed west toward Downtown, transition onto all the eastbound lanes of Nimitz Highway, right Smith Street (two maukabound lanes), right N. King Street (three makai lanes), continuing east on the three makai lanes of S. King Street, right Punchbowl Street (three ewa side lanes), left onto Ala Moana Boulevard (three westbound lanes). At South Street, runners will transition back onto the eastbound lanes of Ala Moana Boulevard to Waikiki, right Kalakaua Avenue (three makai lanes), left Monsarrat Avenue (two kokohead side lanes), mauka onto Monsarrat Avenue(two mauka-bound lanes) between Paki Avenue and Trousseau Street, onto the eastbound lanes of Diamond Head Road (mauka-bound), continue on the eastbound lanes of Diamond Head Road to circle the Crater. At the Diamond Head Road/Paikau Street intersection (Triangle Park), continue west on Diamond Head Road (all ewa-bound lanes), right Paki Avenue, left Kalakaua Avenue (ewa-bound/mauka side lanes) to the finish point at the Honolulu Marathon Finish Line near the Kapiolani Park Tennis Courts.

Buses on the following routes will <u>DETOUR</u> as outlined below. SERVICE ALL BUS STOPS ALONG YOUR DETOUR ROUTE.

Route A, CityExpress!

Eastbound: Regular route east on King to service Downtown from the traffic lane next to the run course

cones. (Express bus stops are at King/Maunakea; King/Bethel; King/Alakea; and

King/Punchbowl). From the King/Punchbowl bus stop, regular route.

Westbound: No detour

Route B, CityExpress!

Eastbound: Regular route east on King to service Downtown from the traffic lane next to the run course

cones. (Express stops are at King/Maunakea; King/Bethel; King/Alakea; and King/Punchbowl). From the King/Punchbowl bus stop, regular route east to Kalakaua/Ena bus stop. DETOUR by veering to the left lanes of Kalakaua Avenue to turn left Kuhio, left Kanabula sight Looki to temporary terminus by Baki Bark (Looki) akimau)

Kapahulu, right Leahi to temporary terminus by Paki Park (Leahi/Lakimau).

Westbound: From Paki Park terminus, east on Leahi, right Monsarrat, right Paki, left Kapahulu, right

Kuhio, resuming regular route.

Route C, CountryExpress!

Eastbound: Regular route east on King to service Downtown from the traffic lane next to the run course

cones. (Express bus stops are at King/Maunakea; King/Bethel; King/Alakea; and

King/Punchbowl). From the King/Punchbowl bus stop, regular route east to AMC.

Westbound: No detour.

Route E, CountryExpress!

Eastbound:

Regular route to Bishop/Hotel bus stop. Veer to the left lanes of Bishop, DETOUR left King, right Punchbowl, left Queen, right Ward, left Auahi, left Kamakee, right Queen, left Waimanu, left Piikoi, right Kona to service the Kona/Kona Iki (Stop #10) and Kona/Keeaumoku (Stop #3) bus stops, east on Kona, right Mahukona (service bus stop ewa of Atkinson Drive), left Atkinson, right Kapiolani, right Kalakaua, left Kuhio, left Kapahulu, right Leahi to the temporary terminus by Paki Park (Leahi/Lakimau).

Westbound:

From the Paki Park terminus, east on Leahi, right Monsarrat, right Paki, left Kapahulu, right Kuhio. At the Kuhio/Kalaimoku intersection, DETOUR by continuing west on Kuhio Avenue, right Kalakaua, right Pau, left Ala Wai, left Niu, onto Ala Moana. DETOUR right South, onto Alapai, left Beretania, left Richards, right Hotel, right Alakea, resuming regular route.

Route 1, Kaimuki-Kalihi Route 9, Palolo Valley-Pearl Harbor

Eastbound:

Regular route to the Richards/King intersection. Turn left into the two mauka traffic lanes of King, then service the King/Punchbowl bus stop from the traffic lane next to the run course cones. From this bus stop, resume regular route.

Westbound:

No detour.

Route 2, Waikiki-School-Middle

Eastbound:

Regular route to the Richards/King intersection. Turn left into the two mauka traffic lanes of King, then service the King/Punchbowl bus stop from the traffic lane next to the run course cones. From this bus stop, resume regular route east to the Kuhio/Kapahulu temporary bus DETOUR left Kapahulu, right Leahi to the temporary Paki Park terminus (Leahi/Lakimau).

Westbound: From Paki Park terminus, east on Leahi, right Monsarrat, right Paki, resuming regular route.

Route 3, Kaimuki-Salt Lake

Eastbound:

Regular route to the Richards/King intersection. Turn left into the two mauka traffic lanes of King, then service the King/Punchbowl bus stop from the traffic lane next to the run course cones. From this bus stop, resume regular route east to Kilauea/Makapuu. DETOUR by continuing makai on Kilauea, left 18th, resuming regular route.

Westbound:

No detour. USE CAUTION on Diamond Head Road between 18th Avenue and Makapuu Avenue. Runners will be using the eastbound Diamond Head Road lanes.

Route 4, Nuuanu-Punahou

Eastbound:

Veer to the left lanes of Nuuanu Regular route to the Nuuanu/Hotel intersection. approaching King Street. Turn left onto the two mauka lanes of King, servicing the King/Bethel; King/Alakea; and King/Punchbowl bus stops from the traffic lane next to the run course cones. Resume regular route to the Kuhio/Kapahulu temporary bus stop. DETOUR left Kapahulu, right Leahi to the temporary terminus by Paki Park (Leahi/Lakimau).

Westbound:

From the Paki Park terminus, east on Leahi, right Monsarrat, right Paki, left Kapahulu, resuming regular route west to the Punchbowl/Beretania bus stop. Beretania, left Nuuanu, left King, left Bethel, resuming regular route.

Route 6, Pauoa-Woodlawn

Eastbound:

Regular route to the Bishop/Hotel bus stop. Veer to the left lanes of Bishop, DETOUR left King, right Punchbowl (2 kokohead lanes), left Queen, right Ward, left Auahi,. DETOUR left Kamakee, right Queen, left Waimanu, left Piikoi, right Kona, resuming regular route.

Westbound:

Regular route to the Queen/South intersection. DETOUR right South, onto Alapai, left Beretania, left Richards, right Hotel, right Alakea, resuming regular route.

Route 8, Waikiki-Ala Moana

Eastbound:

Regular route to Mahukona/Atkinson. DETOUR left Atkinson, right Kapiolani, right Kalakaua to the Kalakaua/Ena bus stop. Veer to the left lanes of Kalakaua, left Kuhio to the DETOUR left Atkinson, right Kapiolani, right temporary bus stop at Kuhio/Kapahulu. DETOUR left Kapahulu, right Leahi to the Paki Park temporary terminus (Leahi/Lakimau).

Westbound:

From the Paki Park temporary terminus, east on Leahi, right Monsarrat, right Paki, left Kapahulu, right Kuhio to the Kuhio/Kalaimoku intersection. DETOUR by continuing west on Kuhio, right Kalakaua, right Pau, left Ala Wai, left Niu, onto Ala Moana, resuming regular route to AMC makai bus stop, right Piikoi, right Kona to the Kona/Keeaumoku bus stop.

Route 11, Makalapa-Halawa-Alea Heights Route 54, Honolulu-Pearl City

Eastbound: Regular route to the Richards/King intersection. Turn left into the two mauka traffic lanes of

King, then service the King/Punchbowl bus stop from the traffic lane next to the run course

cones. From this point, resume regular route to Alapai Express Lot.

Westbound: No detour.

Route 13, Waikiki-Liliha

Eastbound: Regular route to the Richards/King intersction. Turn left into the two mauka traffic lanes of

King; then service the King/Punchbowl stop from the traffic lane next to the run course cones. From this point, resume regular route to the temporary terminus at

Campbell/Monsarrat. DO NOT LAYOVER AT MONSARRAT/KANAINA.

Westbound: From the temporary terminus at Campbell/Monsarrat, right Monsarrat (HPD will direct

traffic), right Leahi, resuming regular route.

Route 14, St. Louis-Kahala-Maunalani

Eastbound: Regular route to Kapahulu/Lemon. DETOUR right Lemon, right Paoakalani, right Kuhio, left

Kapahulu, right Campbell, left Hayden, right Alohea, left Makapuu, right Kilauea, right

Elepaio, left Kahala, resuming regular route.

Westbound: Regular route to Kahala/Paikau (Triangle Park). DETOUR right Paikau, right Diamond

Head Road toward KCC, onto Monsarrat, right Paki, resuming regular route.

Route 19, Waikiki-Airport-Hickam Route 20, Waikiki-Pearlridge Route 42, Ewa Beach-Waikiki

<u>Eastbound</u>: Regular route east on King to service Downtown from the traffic lane next to the run course

cones. Service King Street bus stops to the King/Punchbowl bus stop. DETOUR right around the traffic island onto the two makai-bound kokohead side lanes of Punchbowl, left Queen, right Ward, left Auahi, left Kamakee, right Queen, left Waimanu, left Piikoi, right Kona, right Mahukona, left Atkinson, right Kapiolani, right Kalakaua, left Kuhio to the temporary bus stop at Kuhio/Kapahulu. DETOUR left Kapahulu, right Leahi to the

temporary terminus at Paki Park (Leahi/Lakimau).

Westbound: From the Paki Park terminus, east on Leahi, right Monsarrat, right Paki, left Kapahulu, right Kuhio. At the Kuhio/Kalaimoku intersection, DETOUR by continuing west on Kuhio, right

Kalakaua, right Pau, left Ala Wai, left Niu, onto Ala Moana to Ala Moana/South. DETOUR

right South, onto Alapai, left Beretania, resuming regular route.

Route 22, Beach Bus Route 23, Hawaii Kai-Sea Life Park Route 24, Aina Haina-Ala Moana

Eastbound: Regular route to the Kuhio/Kapahulu temporary bus stop. DETOUR left Kapahulu, right

Campbell, left Hayden, right Alohea, left Makapuu, right Kilauea, resuming regular route

after crossing 18th Avenue.

Westbound: No detour. USE CAUTION when westbound on Diamond Head Road and Monsarrat

Avenue heading to Paki Avenue.

Route 55, Kaneohe-Circle Island Route 56, Honolulu-Kailua-Kaneohe Route 57, Kailua-Waimanalo-Sea Life Park Route 57A, Kailua-Enchanted Lake

Eastbound (From Windward/Pali to AMC): Regular route to the Bishop/Hotel bus stop. Veer to the left lanes of Bishop, DETOUR left King to the King/Punchbowl bus stop, servicing the stop in the traffic lane closest to the run course cones. Turn right around the traffic island to the two left lanes of Punchbowl, left Queen, right Ward, left Auahi, left Kamakee, right Queen, left Waimanu, left Piikoi, right Kona to the Windward terminus.

Westbound (From AMC to Pali/Windward): Regular route west to Ala Moana/South intersection.

DETOUR right South, onto Alapai, left Beretania, left Richards, right Hotel, right Alakea, resuming regular route.

Route 65, Honolulu-Kahaluu

Eastbound (From AMC/Kakaako to Pali/Windward):

- AMC-KONA TERMINUS TRIPS -From the Windward terminus, regular route east on Kona, right Atkinson, right Ala Moana to the Ala Moana/South intersection. DETOUR right South, onto Alapai, left Beretania, left Richards, right Hotel, right Alakea, resuming regular route to Kahaluu.
- <u>ILALO/CORAL TERMINUS TRIPS</u> From the temporary terminus east on Auahi fronting the Ward Warehouse shops, continue east on Auahi, left Kamakee, left Kapiolani, left Ward, right Ala Moana to the Ala Moana/South intersection. DETOUR right South, onto Alapai, left Beretania, left Richards, right Hotel, right Alakea, resuming regular route to Kahaluu.
- Westbound (From Windward/Pali to AMC): Regular route to the Bishop/Hotel bus stop. Veer to the left lanes of Bishop, DETOUR left King to the King/Punchbowl bus stop, servicing bus stop in the traffic lane closest to the run course cones. Turn right around the traffic island to the two left lanes of Punchbowl, left Queen, right Ward, left Auahi. FROM THIS POINT:
 - <u>ILALO/CORAL TERMINUS TRIPS</u> Terminate eastbound on Auahi fronting Ward Warehouse and opposite Marukai Marketplace.
 - <u>AMC-KONA TERMINUS TRIPS</u> Continue east on Auahi, left Kamakee, right Queen, left Waimanu, left Piikoi, right Kona to the Windward terminus.

Route 201, Waipahu via Farrington Express Route 202, Waipahu via Paiwa Express

- NOTE: Nimitz Highway in the eastbound direction will be CLOSED at Nimitz/Smith Street. Ala Moana Boulevard will be CLOSED eastbound from the Ala Moana/Alakea intersection and westbound from the Ala Moana/South to Alakea intersections.
- Eastbound A.M. Operations: Regular route EAST on the H-1 Freeway along the Airport Viaduct. DETOUR by continuing EAST on the H-1 Freeway, right EXIT "23 PUNAHOU ST," right Punahou, right Beretania, left Kalakaua to the Kalakaua/Ena intersection bus stop. CONTINUE the DETOUR by veering to the left lanes of Kalakaua, left Kuhio to the temporary bus stop at Kuhio/Kapahulu. DETOUR left Kapahulu, right Leahi to the temporary terminus at Paki Park (Leahi/Lakimau). Layover as needed or proceed directly to your Car House Facility or your next "SWING" destination.

Westbound P.M. Operations: No detour.

NOT IN SERVICE TRIPS STARTING IN DOWNTOWN HONOLULU

Eastbound Dillingham Boulevard, N. King Street, Vineyard Boulevard, H-1 Freeway East, and Nimitz Highway up to Smith Street will be available for regular traffic. The two (2) mauka lanes of King Street will also be available for regular traffic flow between Smith Street and Punchbowl Street. The outbound Alakea/King bus stop will be available for service; however, a notice will be posted to direct ALL BUS RIDERS TO BOARD BUSES AT THE ALAKEA/HOTEL (District Court) bus stop. Use any of the above streets to reach your starting point if you are affected by the Hapalua Half Marathon Run road closures.
