legally blind high school age students!**

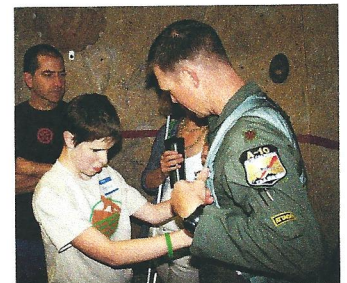

The event will be held on Sunday, May 7, 2017 from 10:00 am until noon. Reservations are MANDATORY and must be received no later than April 21, 2017. This will be on a first come, first served basis. The event is being coordinated by Courageous Kids Climbing, an organization that provides FREE opportunities for children with special needs, physical or developmental, to experience the various forms of rock climbing, holding events in Idaho, Washington and California.

The Courageous Kids Scholarship provides a \$1000 scholarship to a student with special needs from Idaho or eastern Washington to attend the University of Idaho.

This event will be held on a military installation. These instructions must be followed completely or you and your child will not be allowed to participate! This *completed* form must be returned to Courageous Kids Climbing at least two weeks prior to the event to insure it gets processed by the military. Only one child and no more than two caregivers will be allowed to participate. **You will be entering a military installation.** You must check-in at the front gate and each adult must be prepared to present a valid identification card, like a driver's license or DoD identification card along with vehicle registration and proof of insurance. You, your vehicle and your possessions are subject to search at any time by the Security Forces. You cannot take photos of the aircraft parking areas behind the fence (flightline), however, this may change the day of the event. DO NOT try to drive through any gates onto the flightline without permission and/or an escort. Photos of the flightline is prohibited but may be authorized the day of the event. Photos of the aircraft and military vehicles on permanent display in the administration area is authorized as long as the photos do not include any aircraft on the flightline, subject to change. When you get within 25-feet of the aircraft, you cannot wear any jewelry to include necklaces, rings, bracelets, etc. If you must wear your wedding ring, please let us know and we will tape over it. All pockets above the waist must be empty. Sunglasses cannot be worn when looking at the cockpit and prescription eyeglasses should be secured or removed. Prior to taking a photo of a member of the military, you must have their permission and the aircraft cannot be in the photo. If any of these requirements are not followed, you will be escorted off of the installation!
