

## DRAGON SKIN SCARF

Onix Terevinto Knitwear Designs
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Multiple 26 stitches
In my scarf I added 2 stitches at each end which will be knit in all rows. You can make it as wide as you want just increasing 26 stitches for each panel. The sample shows it done with 26 stitches for the pattern +4 sts( two at each end)

Materials: Manos del Uruguay merino/silk blend Needles \# 9

Gauge is NOT important
Remember to put a stitch marker after the stitches for the edges and KNIT those in all rows.

The stitch count does not change in the pattern rows, you'll always have 26 stitches on each section (if you want it wider remember to increase by 26 stitches)

Row: 1 -
(Wrong side) * purl repeat from *
Row: 2- * k1, M1, ssk, k4, k2-tog, k3, M1, K2, M1, k3, ssk, k4, k2-tog, M1, k1 (26 sts)

Row: 4-* k1, M1, k1, ssk, K2, k2-tog, k4, M1, K2, M1, k4, ssk, K2, k2-tog, k1, M1, k1

Row: 6* k1, M1, K2, ssk, k2-tog, k5, M1, K2, M1, k5, ssk, k2-tog, K2, M1, k1

Row: 8-*k1, M1, k3, ssk, k4, k2-tog, M1, K2, M1, ssk, k4, k2-tog, k3, M1, k1

Row: 10-*k1, M1, k4, ssk, K2, k2-tog, k1, M1, K2, M1, k1, ssk, K2, k2-tog, k4, M1, k1

Row: 12-* K1, M1, k5, ssk, k2-tog, K2, (M1, K2) twice, ssk, k2tog, k5, M1, k1

Repeat these 12 rows as many times as the desired length.
Bind off, hand wash and block!
