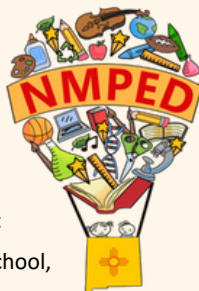
Families of children with disabilities will receive support in navigating the special education process, focusing on topics such as:
