### **Helpful Information for the Position**

- All full-time Positions but may consider splitting shifts
- flexible with accommodations
- Starting pay \$13.00/hour
- Need to be at least 18 years old
- Only first shift: 6:00 AM 3:00 PM
  - o Can be flexible to start up to 7:00 AM
  - Volume driven
- Cross Functionality
  - o Entry level try to do the same position until comfortable to learn another position
- Tools used for teardown
  - Air guns
  - o Electric screwdrivers
  - o Sometimes will need
    - Pry bar
    - Hamer
    - Wire cutters
    - Anything necessary to take apart order
- Key Skills and characteristics:
  - o Ability to identify a computer, server, monitor/TV, router, phone...
  - Basic knowledge of computers and computer parts
    - Ability to identify components of a computer like the hard drive, memory and CPU
  - o Ability to read at a basic level
  - Want to work
  - Productive
    - Keep up with the pace
  - Good attendance
  - o Punctual
- Evaluation/Review
  - o Work closely with a supervisor or mentor for the first week or 2
  - o 90-day probation period
  - Annual reviews
- Physical Requirements
  - o Lift up to 40lbs
  - o Able to be on feet for most of the shift
  - o Standing or mobile for most of the shift
- Production goals by assets processed
  - Different asset goal for each department
- Attire/PPE
  - o Gloves cut gloves and sleeve
  - Steel toe or composite toe shoes
  - Safety Glasses
  - Everything is provided except for the steel toes

- Environment conditions
  - Unconditioned
    - warmer in summer and cooler in winter
    - fans running in summer
  - o Large, open shop floor
  - Fluorescent lights (somewhat bright)
  - Tall ceilings (30+ feet)
  - o 1 Large fan on Ceiling
  - Smaller fans out on floor
  - Constant light background noise
    - Fans and hum of machines
  - Noise from pneumatic tools
- Drug testing/Background check
- Prior work experience preferred but not necessary
- 1 paid break (15 minutes) and a 1 hour un-paid lunch
- Smoking is allowed in designated areas outside
- Time clock check in

### **Interviewing Process**

• Online application process:

- Quick phone screen
  - Schedule email
- Face-to-face interview
  - Job coaches are welcome
    - Want candidate to be comfortable
  - 1 hour or more
    - Take a tour of the workplace
    - Get applicants feedback
  - Very informal
    - Ask questions to get candidates to open up and talk, have a conversation

## On the Job Training

### **Training:**

- 1 to 2 weeks of on-the-job training
  - o Hands on
  - Work closely with a supervisor or mentor for the first week
