*What is HB 1282? Sponsored by Representative Carl Gilliard, HB 1282 will assure that the individualized education program (IEP), of each blind or visually impaired child includes provisions for instruction in Braille and the use of Braille appropriate to the child's current and future literacy needs. *Why is it important? Instruction in Braille reading and writing will enable each blind or visually impaired child to communicate effectively and efficiently with the same level of proficiency expected of the child's peers of comparable ability and grade level.

*Who does it impact? It impacts every blind and visually impaired student in the state of Georgia.
