Of course there will be no charge and no age limit.

In addition to the annual Blind Surfing Event, the Encinitas Lions Club works on a variety of projects designed to help the sight impaired, such as free diabetes and eye testing clinics, eye glass recycling, prescription eye glasses, Guide Dogs for the Blind and Audible Traffic Signals throughout our city.
