WORKPLACE RESOURCES AND TECHNOLOGY**

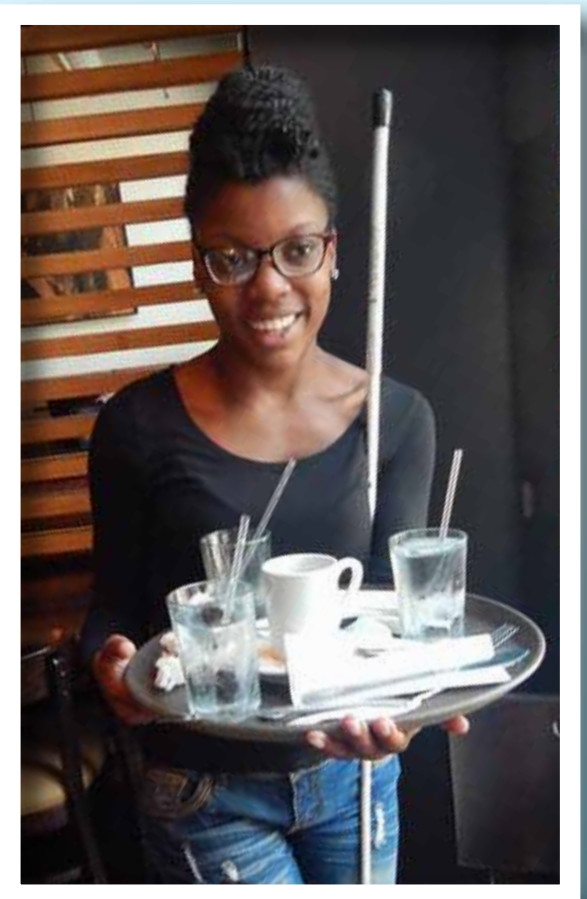
Learn skills for advocacy and explore technologies available to use at work.
