JOB DESCRIPTION

Job Summary: Under general direction, provides leadership for and coordination of University services for students with disabilities; counsels students with physical and learning disabilities; arranges accommodations; facilitates training and resources for faculty and staff in the area of disabilities; serves as representative with various organizations internal and external to the University; supervises staff who oversee and coordinate testing services.

CHARACTERISTIC JOB TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES May include any and/or all of the following:

- 1. Provides leadership and supervision for disabilities services department and related staff.
- Plans and coordinates University services to students with physical and learning disabilities, in cooperation with various campus departments; assesses needs of diverse services.
- 3. Interacts with faculty and various departmental personnel to arrange adequate physical classroom accommodations; develops faculty and staff awareness activities.
- 4. Makes arrangements for student placements and services reimbursement with state vocational rehabilitation agencies; serves as University representative with local and national disability organizations.
- 5. Interprets test results and behavioral information related to learning disabilities; monitors progress of individual student academic, personal, and social development plans; performs other duties as assigned.
