Michigan Department of Education - Low Incidence Outreach and Camp tuhsmehta (Camp T) are pleased to announce the first Family Nature Club event: The Great Backyard Bird Count (GBBC). GBBC is a free, fun, and easy event that engages bird watchers of all ages in counting birds to create a real-time snapshot of bird populations. Participants are asked to count birds for as little as 15 minutes (or as long as they wish) and report their sightings online at birdcount.org. In addition participants can snowshoe, hike, play in the snow and drink hot chocolate by the campfire.
