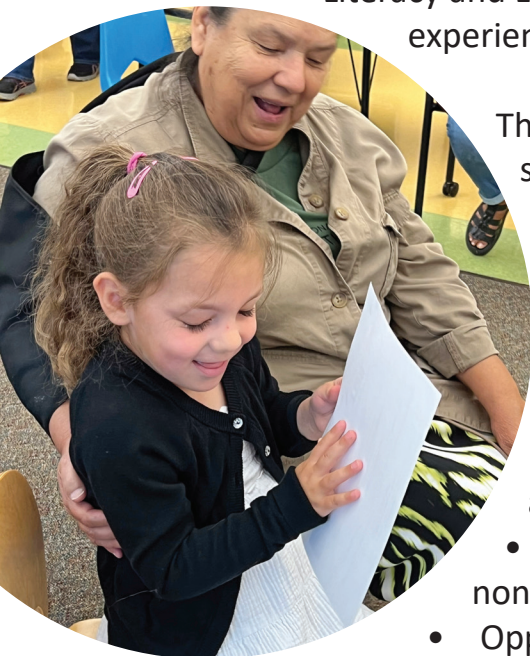




NFB BELL® Academy: A Summer Program for Blind and Low-Vision Youth
