### DIRECTIONS AND PARKING INFORMATION:



Free Parking will be provided in the Arch Parking Garage located on Washington Avenue (to the east of Memorial Drive).

Upon leaving the garage, walk through the grounds of the park heading south to the Arch.

Entrance to the Arch will be under the north leg of the Arch (closest to the park-ing garage).

**Drop Off** at Old Cathedral parking lot allowed after 6:15 pm (after Mass ends.) The Old Cathedral parking lot is located at Memorial and Walnut Streets.

Call-A-Ride and Taxi-Cabs Please Schedule Arrival at 6:15 PM or later and Pick-Up at 8:30 PM. Drop-off and Pick-up Point at Old Cathedral (off Memorial Dr.)

Upon Arrival at the North Entrance of the Arch you will go through secruity screening at the entrance. Please be aware that you may have to remove contents from pockets, metal objects, and belts and place them in a tray to be screened. No weapons, including knives are allowed.
