Attend the National Federation of the Blind (NFB) BELL[®] (Braille Enrichment for Literacy and Learning) Academy, a transformative learning experience for blind and low-vision youth. Through engaging activities and hands-on learning, participants will deepen their Braille literacy and learn nonvisual skills to build confidence and independence.

Activities Include:

- Interactive Braille lessons that celebrate two-hundred years of tactile literacy.
- Inspiring stories of blind inventors and change-makers.
- Learn about the enduring legacy of Louis Braille.
