## REQUIREMENTS

**SPECIAL NOTE**: Appointment to this title will be made provisionally, pending the outcome of an open-competitive examination. If selected for the position, you must apply for the open-competitive examination, when issued by the Civil Service Commission, pass and be reachable on the resulting eligible list to be permanently appointed to the title.

<u>LICENSE</u>: Appointee will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.
