Disability Equity Center seeks an **Executive Director** to build a non-profit grassroots organization for social justice leadership. This full-time, paid position will work closely with Corvallis area community, local healthcare providers and social services, area school districts, and Oregon State University.

Responsibilities include budgeting, fundraising, strategic planning, and oversight of daily operations such as DEC activities and supervision of volunteers. High adaptability, visionary thinking, disability pride, and a demonstrable deep commitment to social justice and disability equity are required.

Previous experience in building non-profit organizations, social media skills, and multi-lingual candidates are preferred.

Disability Equity Center is an inclusive cultural center for people living with disabilities in Oregon's Willamette Valley, as well as their family and friends. DEC aids navigation of resources and systems by making connections, bridging gaps, and creating partnerships with local and national disability support services. DEC offers community education and outreach, and confronts ableism and social misperceptions about people with disabilities.
