The Disability Law Center of Alaska (DLC) is an independent non-profit law firm providing legal advocacy for people with disabilities, anywhere in Alaska.

#### Who we help

Individuals with traumatic brain injury, mental illness, physical disabilities, and intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD).

#### What we assist with

- Some Social Security applications and some higher-level appeals;
- Medicaid/Medicare appeals;
- Physical barriers/access to businesses, services, and voting;
- Access to appropriate Special Education programs;
- Social Security representative payee performance reviews;
- ❖ Disability-related financial exploitation or employment discrimination;
- Complaints about the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation (DVR) or an Independent Living Center;
- Establish and maintain contact with residents who live in facilities through monitoring;
- Outreach, intake, and/or, training events to inform of DLC's services and the legal rights
  of people with disabilities;
- Systemic activities, such as educating policy makers, reviewing and investigating how policies affect people with disabilities;
- ❖ Investigate reports of abuse and neglect of individuals with disabilities, as well as assess how well agencies investigate complaints of abuse and neglect.




