Smell and touch to learn about native plants and habitats. Listen to the unique sounds of different ecosystems, and taste refreshing iced tea brewed straight from the preserve's plants. Feel alligator skin, Venus flytraps, and pitcher plants, and examine a deer pelt, bobcat and otter mounts, feathers, fossils, and animal antlers.
