

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

This notice of public hearing announces OOD's intention to file a rescinded and new chapter 2 rule in accordance with Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code. The reason for filing the proposed rule is to update the Vocational Rehabilitation Fee Schedule.

The purpose of this hearing is to provide the opportunity for any interested person to give testimony for or against the proposed Ohio Administrative Code rule. Testimony for the proposal or against it may be made either at the public hearing or in writing to the Executive Director before the public hearing. Questions about this rule will not be entertained at the public hearing, but may be addressed to the Executive Director either before or after the public hearing.
