Online open house and survey now live!

The City of Shoreline is creating a plan to make Shoreline's parks easier to use for people with disabilities. This is called the Park Facilities Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Transition Plan. The plan will look for problems that make it hard for people to move around Shoreline's park facilities and suggest ways to fix them.

To help write this plan, the City is hosting an online open house and survey to learn about your experiences. Getting feedback from the community helps the City focus on the most important improvements. We invite you to share your thoughts so we can make Shoreline parks more accessible and welcoming for everyone.
