The City of Alexandria has joined the nationwide "Smart911" service, which lets residents, businesses and visitors provide information to 9-1-1 dispatchers in advance of emergencies.

The free Smart911 service allows individuals and businesses to create profiles with home, work and mobile phone numbers and attach information that would be valuable to dispatchers and first responders.

This information – which can include medical issues, emergency contacts, pet ownership, vehicle details, and more – can help Police, Fire and EMS to assist you.
