

Changes coming soon for S Columbian Way Paving Project

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) is planning to repave S Columbian Way between Beacon Ave S and 15th Ave S in 2010. This project is part of the "Bridging the Gap" transportation levy approved by Seattle voters.

These changes are designed to:

- Repave the street
- Install new curb
- Improve drainage
- Construct new curb ramps at intersections to improve pedestrian access

This segment of Columbian Way S is also being restriped as part of this project.

The proposed changes include:

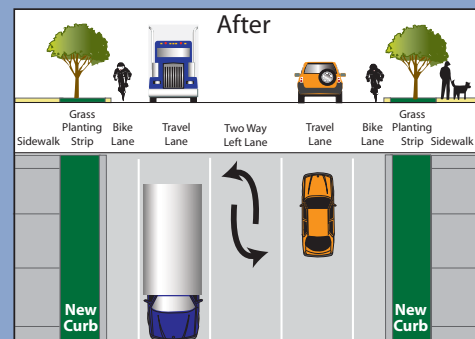
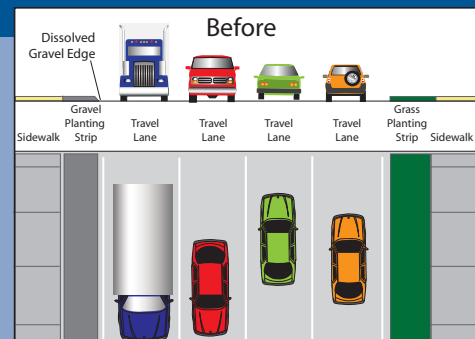
- One lane of motor vehicle traffic in each direction
- A new two-way center turn lane
- New bike lanes
- A new dedicated right-turn lane at VA Hospital Drive to improve access to the medical center

The new configuration will improve motor vehicle safety and access, pedestrian access and bicycle usage.
