

Pacific Foundation for Blind Children (PFBC) Scholarship Application

The Pacific Foundation for Blind Children is pleased to announce that we are accepting applications for our 2022 Scholarship Program. We will award three (3) \$1,500 scholarships to three outstanding blind/low vision high school seniors in Washington State. These scholarships will be awarded directly to the selected applicants and the funds may be used for expenses at their discretion.

The deadline for applications is June 30, 2022.

All applicants must satisfy all of the following qualifications to be considered for a scholarship award:

- 1. The applicant must be legally blind in both eyes. Legal Blindness is defined as an individual who has a visual acuity of 20/200 or less in the corrected eye and/or 20° or less visual field in the corrected eye.
- 2. Residents of the state of Washington. The applicant must be a resident of Washington State as defined by an individual who has PHYSICALLY resided in the state of Washington for a period of twelve (12) consecutive months at the time of application.
- 3. The applicant must be a graduating high school senior with plans to obtain higher education; either vocational school, community college, or college/university in the fall of 2022.

Each scholarship application must include:

- 1. Completed scholarship application form. Please "Save As" the PDF form and email with the other items on this list. Be sure to include your last name in the file name of your items.
- 2. An essay describing the applicant's career and academic goals after high school; high school achievements; and explanation of why you feel you are the best candidate for a scholarship award. Include relevant information such as activities, community service, hobbies, and interests, that will help the scholarship committee learn more about you.
- 3. High school transcript. Please provide transcripts from the last school you attended. Scans of the official transcript may be used.
- 4. The applicant must provide proof of enrollment or acceptance to enroll in an accredited vocational school, community college, or college/university in the fall of 2022.

All completed scholarship packets must be emailed to jareda.webb@pfbc1.org and received by June 30, 2022.

APPLICATION PACKETS RECEIVED AFTER JUNE 30 WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED. INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
