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Section 317.20. LEGAL RIGHTS SERVICE NONPROFIT TRANSITION STUDY

- (A) The Legal Rights Service Commission shall conduct a study concerning a potential transition from a public entity to a nonprofit organization effective July 1, 2011. The study shall include an analysis of all of the following:
- (1) The feasibility of a transition to a nonprofit organization;
- (2) The potential effects on service delivery, including client service and access to required resources, and any other service delivery advantages or disadvantages that might result from the transition to a nonprofit organization;
- (3) Potential organizational effects, including cost savings and non-state funding sources, and any other organizational advantages or disadvantages that might result from the transition to a nonprofit organization;
- (4) The approximate amount of time necessary to achieve a transition to nonprofit status.
- (B) The Legal Rights Service Commission shall develop a process plan by which a transition to a nonprofit organization could be implemented not later than July 1, 2011.
- (C) Not later than six months after the effective date of this section, a written report of the results of the study and a copy of the process plan shall be submitted to the Governor, the Speaker and the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives, and the President and the Minority Leader of the Senate.
