Proposed Voting Procedures

For the 2021 virtual convention

As a result of the pandemic, the NFB of Mississippi will be holding a virtual convention. This will cause the convention to consider alternative ways to conduct business than we usually do when we are together in person. None of these proposed procedures are meant to alter our current constitution. The convention remains the supreme authority of the affiliate and the convention must consider and approve any proposed changes.

This will serve as the platform for how we will conduct our elections and any policy adoptions.

- 1. As stated in our constitution, in order to participate in voting, membership must be verified. This is being done by reviewing the Mississippi membership list to prove payment of affiliate dues, and/or verifying with chapter presidents of current chapter membership rosters Members must be present during the business meeting to participate in the elections
- 2. A nominating committee will be assigned by the President as in years past and the nominating committee will make recommendations. Nominations will also be taken from the floor during elections.
- 3. Members will be asked to raise their hands to vote, and three minutes will be allowed for all votes to be cast and three minutes for all votes to be counted.
- 4. Any questions regarding membership or voting will be referred to Angel Darden-Kennedy, who has been assigned the responsibility of handling any questions or issues that may occur during the elections process
