The Penn Museum invites visitors with vision loss to explore the museum through touch and sound!

Visitors with vision loss and their companions are invited to explore the Museum through touch and verbal description.

The program will feature touch

experiences in eight galleries, including a chance to touch the largest Sphinx in North America. Museum staff will be stationed around the building to guide visitors who are blind or visually impaired through the tactile experiences, give verbal descriptions, and offer wayfinding assistance.

Visitors with vision loss who require or prefer sighted guides are encouraged to bring an assistant or companion.

The program is included with regular Museum admission (One sighted companion per visitor receives free admission). No pre-registration is required, but RSVPs to kschott@upenn.edu are strongly encouraged.
